Hello,

I am writing regarding the Boardman Park & Recreation District meeting addressing Parks Master Plan and trail-related matters.

This correspondence is also submitted for inclusion in the Morrow County Planning Commission record for Agenda Items 5.I and 5.II, to ensure clarity regarding same-night sequencing, coordination, and potential reliance.

I am requesting copies of the meeting materials and confirmation of the scope of the proposed action so that I may submit additional written comments into the Park & Recreation District record prior to any vote or final decision.

This request is made in light of the following timing and sequencing context:

- The City of Boardman issued its Notice of Decision for the Parks Master Plan on January 16.
- The Morrow County Planning Commission is considering County Recreation Element and Heritage Trail actions on January 27, 2026, the same date as the Park & Recreation District meeting, following a recent rescheduling.
- These actions involve overlapping corridor geography and subject matter and are proceeding on parallel timelines across separate governing bodies.

Because these actions are occurring on the same date, neither body can meaningfully review or respond to the other's final action, yet later reliance or claims of consistency between agencies may be asserted. I am therefore requesting this information specifically so I can add written material to the Park & Recreation District record before any vote, addressing sequencing, reliance, and coordination clarity.
